
TEACHERS TAKE KIDS

Checking the final standings, we see that all the teams ended in a tie. So will all the people who participated this year please pick up your badges and awards at the gym office.








WAGAR ATHLETE OF THE YEAR



So, on behalf of the athletic directors, we wish to present this honour to you, Wagar Athlete of the Year.












