





Editorial

It is a sad face that the youth of the late 60's, a generation of kids who tried to make it in a world of conformity by being different from the others, have found themselves in a limbo where they can neither move forward nor return to their unique past.

TEACHERS HAVE NO SENSES OF HUMOUR or THE TIME MY TEACHER BROKE HER LEG


Gentlemen, I am here today to prove once and for all that teachers have no sense of humour. I will now proceed to make my point and show my references.
